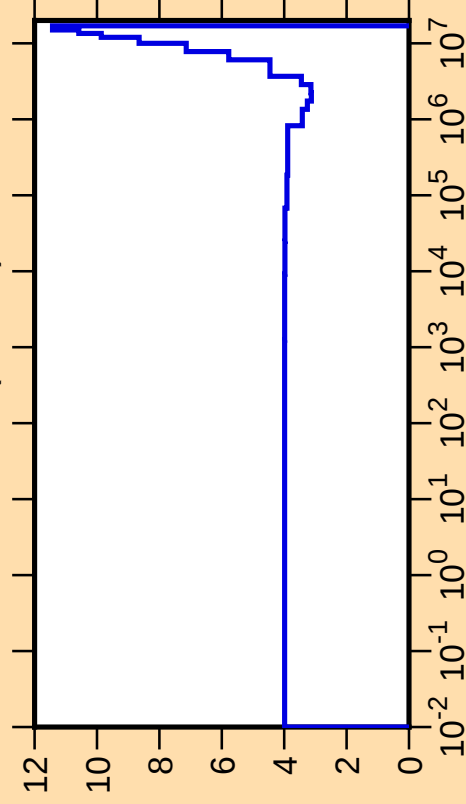


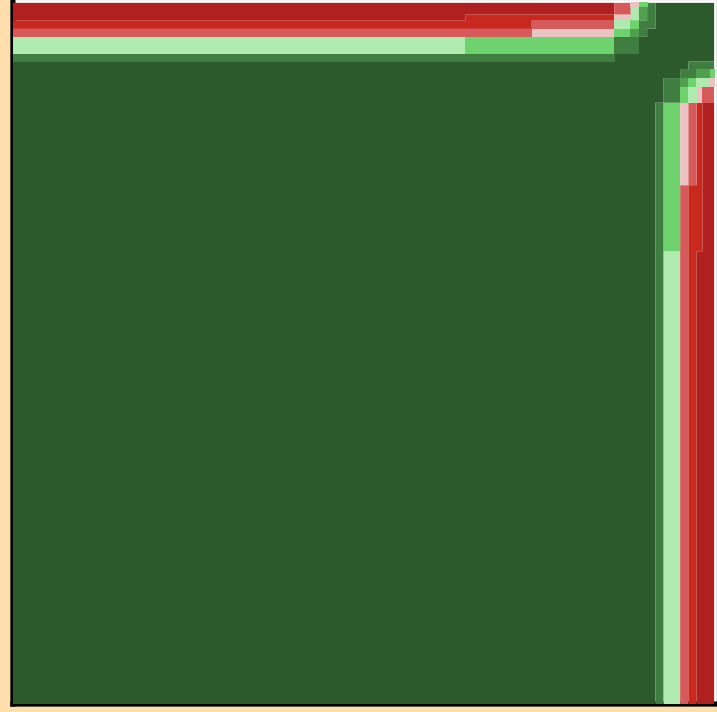
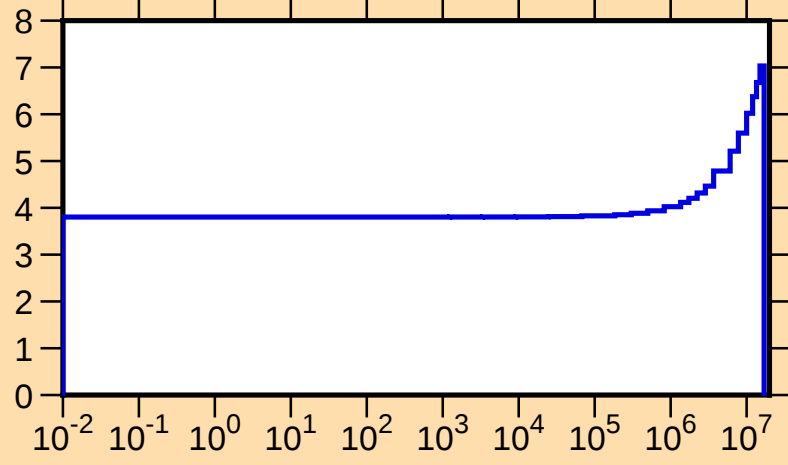
$\Delta v/v$ vs. E for $^{247}\text{Cm}(\text{total } v)$



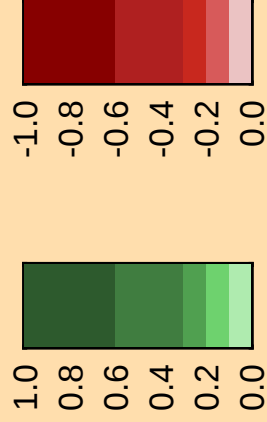

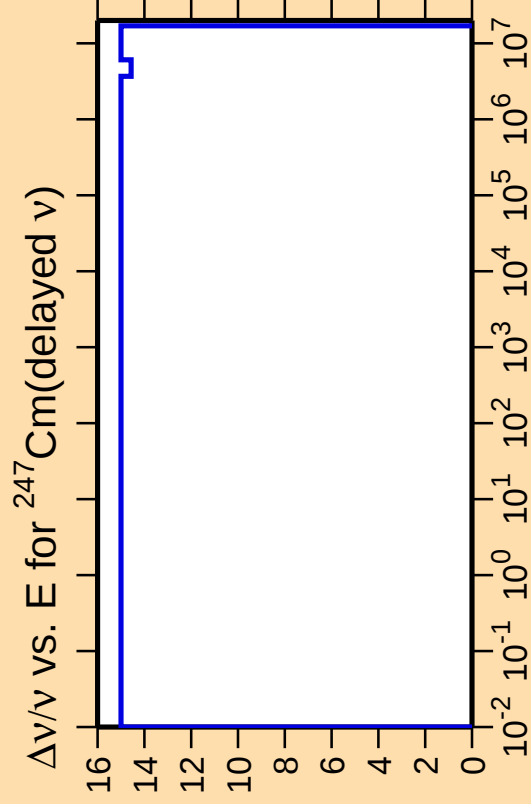

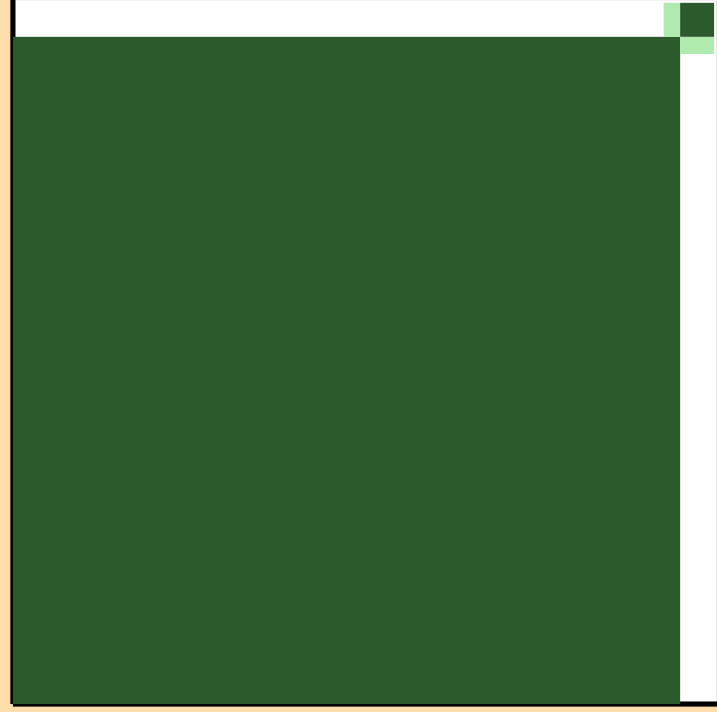
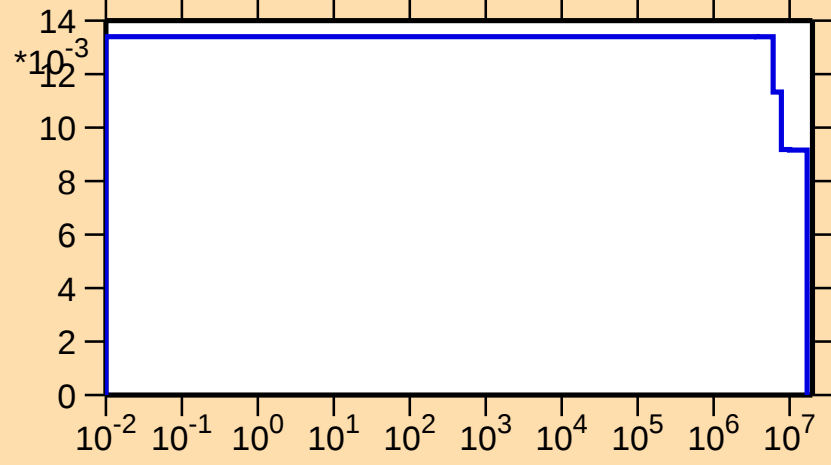
$\Delta v/v$ vs. E for $^{247}\text{Cm}(\text{delayed } \nu)$



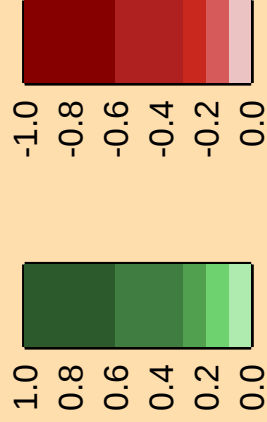

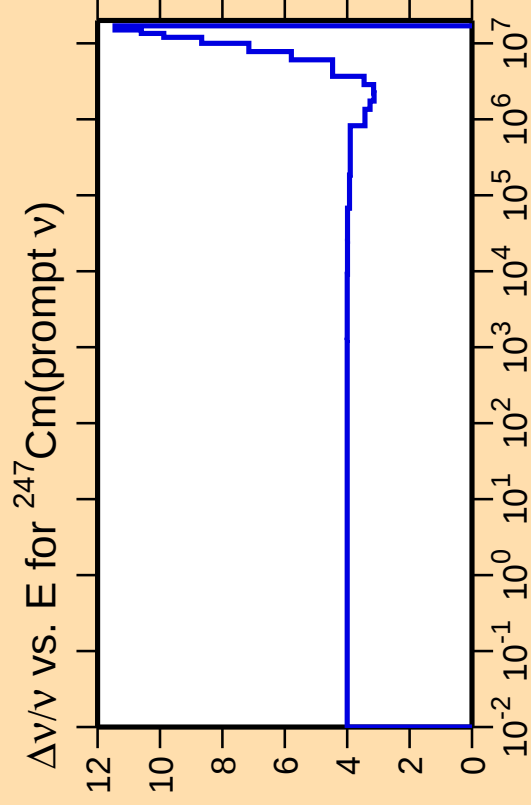

ν vs. E for $^{247}\text{Cm}(\text{delayed } \nu)$



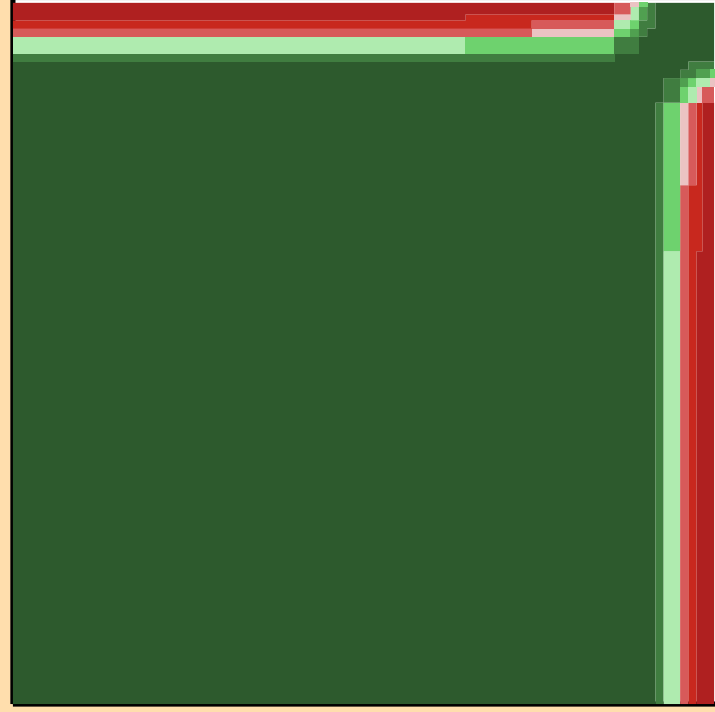
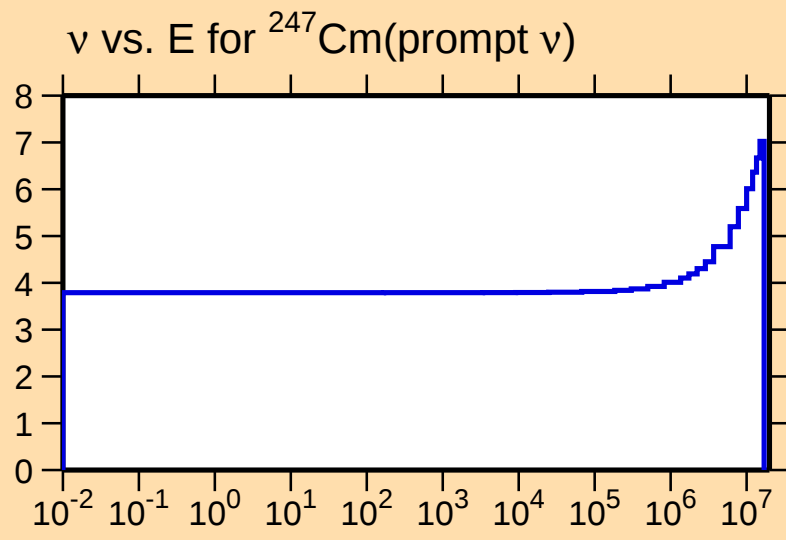
