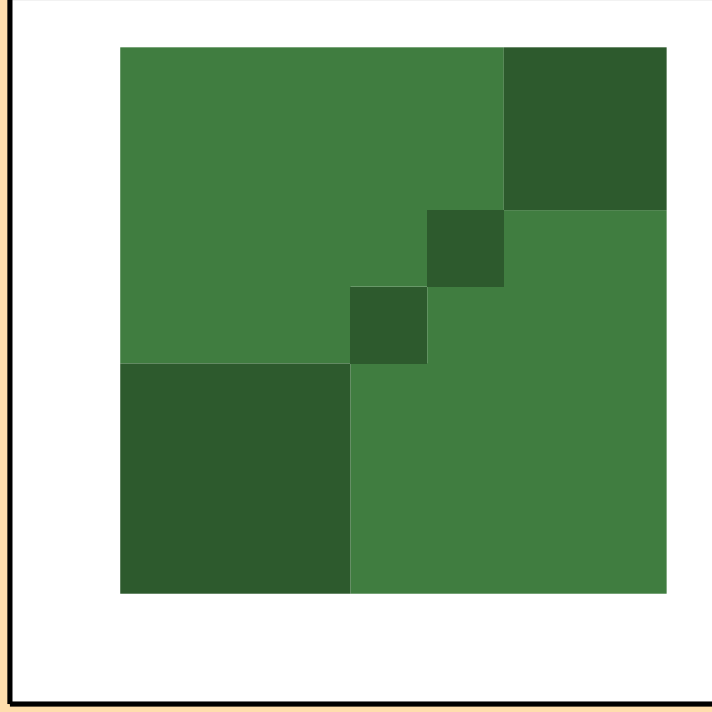
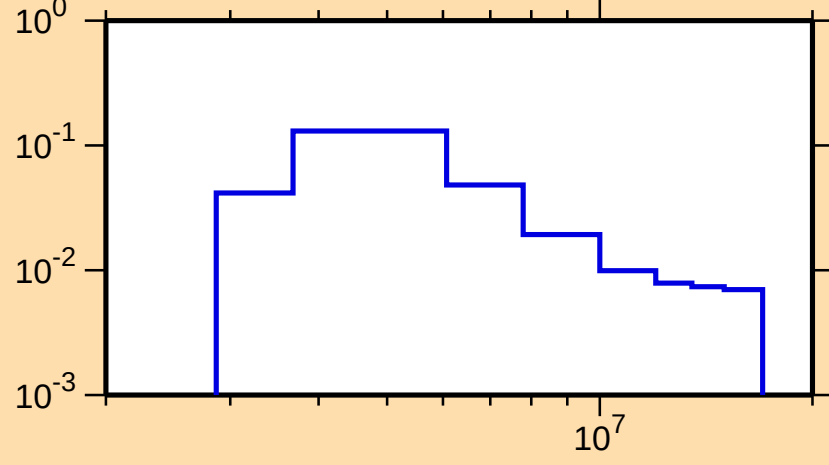
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{52}\text{Cr}(n,n_7)$



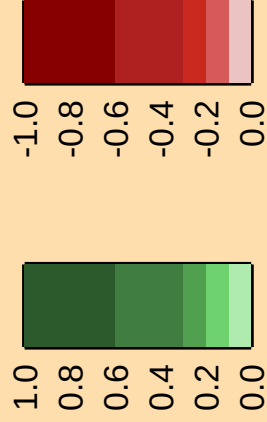

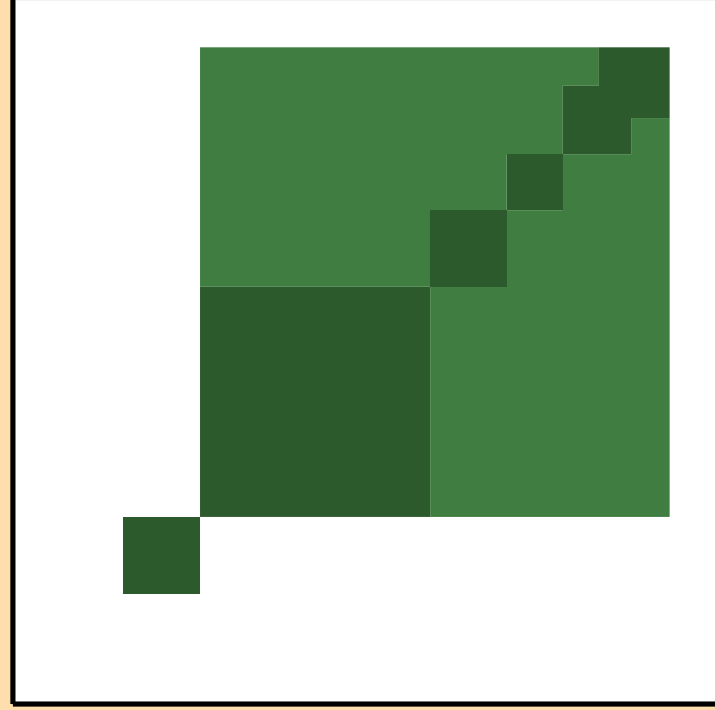
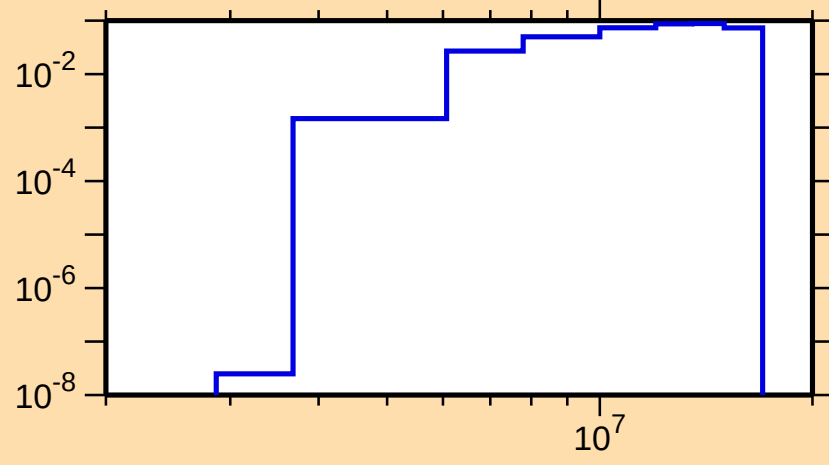
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{52}\text{Cr}(n,p)$



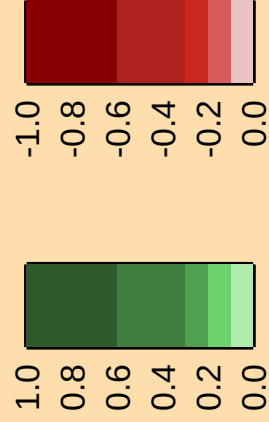
